## WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

**DEADLINE: JUNE 15, 2016**

**Acting Up (grades K-2)**

The basic tools of an actor's trade - observation, memorization, concentration, and imagination are presented and explored in an entertaining manner. The students participate in a variety of fun exercises, learning to apply the actor's tools to both performing and everyday life.

**A Little Improv (grades K-2)**

Participation and teamwork are emphasized as the students learn to act without a script. This workshop can be geared to all skill levels of students from beginners to more experienced performers.

**Creating a Character (grades 3-5)**

Actors and scientists use diverse techniques to reach solutions successfully. Students will discover that these two different approaches to problem solving are quite similar as they utilize theatre exercises to answer scientific questions.

**A Little Improv (grades 3-5)**

Participation and teamwork are emphasized as the students learn to act without a script. This workshop can be geared to all skill levels of students from beginners to more experienced performers.

**Lights, Camera...Yoga? (all ages)**
